Face masks are welcome & available.



*Face Masks are **required** for those with symptoms of a respiratory virus (such as cough, cold, fever, sore throat) or gastrointestinal virus (nausea, vomiting, diarrhea).

You may want to wear a mask if:

You have an underlying medical condition, are immunocompromised, or are an older adult.

Your close contacts are more likely to get very sick if they contract Covid-19.

You have not had Covid-19 or a vaccination for it in the last 90 days.

You had a high-risk exposure and may become sick.

You are caring for a patient who has symptoms of a respiratory virus.
